Examination Week for Years 11

Monday 6 December – Friday 10 December 2021

During examination week, the timetable is collapsed and students are organised to sit exams mainly as a year group in the Assembly Hall or in their teaching group in a designated room. Each year group is allocated a '**Study Day**' when the students stay at home and prepare for their examinations. All students are working through a 'Study Skills' programme with their form tutors and are producing a revision plan on how they can make full use of their study day at home. Students can refer to their study skills pack, as this contains relevant study skills guidance, please feel free to chat to your son/daughter about the contents. Students must come to school during exam week, well prepared, with material to revise from during their study sessions. A detailed copy of the exam timetable for each student is attached. The Occupational Studies pupils attend the SRC as normal on Wednesday 8 December and are not required in school on Friday 10 December. Those pupils not studying English Literature can leave school after their Option A exam is finished at 12.45pm on Wednesday 8 December. The pupils should make their own arrangements for transport. Study facilities for completion of preparation for controlled assessments / revision are available within the College if required.

Please note that Year 11 students must attend BALC courses as normal on Thursday 9 December, unless alternative arrangements have been provided by the BALC school. Transport will be provided to and from the school as normal.
